ARRIVAL TIME Friday, June 18th

For anyone arriving between 11:00 am – 1:30 pm we are meeting at the General Store in Fish Camp and caravanning together from Fish Camp to Green Meadows [see letter]. If you arrive after 1:30 pm, go directly to Jack L. Boyd and park in the parking lot. Please DO NOT arrive early at the Jack L. Boyd Outdoor School campus. At the General Store you can get out of your car, stretch, eat your lunch, and use the bathroom facilities.



Please do not get directions from any Internet map sites. Their directions are technically correct, but they take you through a road that is not paved (very bumpy, could be muddy and you will get stuck if it's recently rained), and is inaccessible during the winter.

The Jack L Boyd Outdoor School at Green Meadows is at the southern entrance to Yosemite National Park in the town of Fish Camp. It is at an elevation of 5,000 feet and experience four distinct seasons per year. The facility is gently level, efficiently laid, and accessible to people with disabilities. The town of Fish Camp provides basic supplies at the General Store, a US Post Office, and Fire and Emergency Response services.

Northern California

From MERCED and NORTHERN CALIFORNIA:

Driving Directions to Jack L. Boyd Outdoor School at Green Meadows

Travel time: allow 2 hours from Merced

- At Merced, from Highway 99 North or South, take Hwy 140 east to Mariposa, about 35 miles.
- As 140 comes into Mariposa, make a hard right onto Hwy 49 south. The turn is before the stop sign. It is just over 26 miles to Oakhurst. 49 will end in a "T" intersection with Hwy 41 at Oakhurst. Turn left at the signal onto Hwy 41 north toward Yosemite. ****Oakhurst is the last/nearest gas & major services****
- Follow 41 north to Fish Camp (it is curvy, allow about 25 minutes) 14 miles
- At Fish Camp you will pass the Apple Tree Inn, Tenaya Lodge, General Store, and the pond. After the pond watch on the right for our green and white Green Meadows sign and the larger, higher, lighted yellow and green White Chief Mountain Lodge sign. These signs mark White Chief Mountain Rd. Turn right onto White Chief Mountain Rd. (paved, narrow) .5 mile
- Follow the small wooden signs that point the way to Green Meadows, passing the White Chief Mountain Lodge. The road is short and paved, but narrow and bumpy until you reach our Green Meadows entrance sign. The driveway down to our parking lot is two-lane paved. Please WATCH FOR PEDESTRIANS!

Southern California

From FRESNO and SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA:

Driving Directions to Jack L. Boyd Outdoor School at Green Meadows

Travel time: allow 1.5 hours from Fresno

- At Fresno, from Highway 99 North or South, take Hwy 41 North to Oakhurst, about 50 miles, approximately 1 hour. ****Oakhurst is the last/nearest gas & major services****
- Continue on 41 north to Fish Camp (it is curvy, allow about 25 minutes) 14 miles
- At Fish Camp you will pass the Apple Tree Inn, Tenaya Lodge, General Store, and the pond. After the pond watch on the right for our green and white Green Meadows sign and the larger, higher, lighted yellow and green White Chief Mountain Lodge sign. These signs mark White Chief Mountain Rd. Turn right onto White Chief Mountain Rd. (paved, narrow) .5 mile
- Follow the small wooden signs that point the way to Green Meadows, passing the White Chief Mountain Lodge. The road is short and paved, but narrow and bumpy until you reach our Green Meadows entrance sign. The driveway down to our parking lot is two-lane paved. Please WATCH FOR PEDESTRIANS!
